

FORM ATTESTING TO GOOD STANDING

FOR LITURGICAL MINISTRIES AND PARISH LEADERSHIP POSITIONS

To serve as a liturgical minister or parish council member, or in other leadership positions in the parish, is a great blessing for the parish and for the volunteer. It is also important that volunteers meet certain requirements and understand the responsibility of their particular position. The following are general requirements for all liturgical ministries and parish leadership positions:

- A person must be committed to Christ and Catholic teaching in its fullness.
- A person should be a practicing Catholic, having received Confirmation and striving to live as a faithful disciple in all areas, understanding also that we are all weak, often fall short, and stand in constant need of God's mercy and help.
- A person needs to be in good standing (i.e., their marriage should be recognized in the Church if married, they should be striving to live their romantic relationship according to Church teaching if not married, and they should not promote any cause or belong to any organization that is at odds with Church teaching).
- A person should be committed to faithfully fulfilling the duties of their ministry and communicate with us if unable to perform them.
